Construction and Maintenance Projects Week of April 21, 2014

Allen County

Interstate 75 Reconstruction Project For the most recent information concerning the Interstate 75 reconstruction project through Lima and Allen County please visit www.odotlima75.org

U.S. 30/Ohio 309 near Delphos may be restricted to one lane at times through the work zone for culvert work. Work is expected to be completed in May. Work is being performed by Platinum Painting, Boardman.

Defiance County

Ohio 2 from Ohio 49 to Ohio 249 will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for sealing of pavement cracks. Work is being performed by the Defiance County ODOT maintenance garage.

Hancock County

Interstate 75 both northbound and southbound lanes are narrowed and shifted approaching the U.S. 224 interchange at Findlay during reconstruction of the interchange. Lane restrictions are occurring on occasion in the southbound direction between 8 p.m. and 10 p.m. mostly during the week but on some weekends as well. Work is being performed by Miller Brothers Construction, Archbold.

U.S. 224 traffic on the bridge over Interstate 75, Findlay, is traveling on the north half of the bridge, one lane in each direction with no turn lanes, during a complete reconstruction of the interchange. All

ramps at the interchange are currently open. The project began in February and is expected to be completed late this fall. Work is being performed by Miller Brothers Construction, Archbold.

U.S. 224 on the east side of Findlay between Plaza Road (Best Buy) and County Road 236 is restricted to one lane through the work zone at times during a traffic signal upgrade project. The project is under way and will continue for an additional two weeks. Work is being performed by Perram Electric, Wadsworth.

Ohio 235 from County Road 304 (old U.S. 30) approximately three miles north of Ada to County Road 313 (old 25) just north of Interstate 75 will be closed beginning Monday, April 21 for 21 days for grinding and paving of the roadway. Traffic will be detoured to U.S. 30 and Ohio 696 and Interstate 75 back to Ohio 235. Work is being performed by Bluffton Paving, Bluffton.

Ohio 698 between the village of Jenera and County Road 313 will be restricted to one lane through the work zone Tuesday through Friday of the week for pavement repair. Traffic will be maintained with flaggers. Work is being performed by the Hancock County ODOT maintenance garage.

Ohio 568 between Lye Creek just west of the Hancock County fairgrounds to County Road 180 will be restricted to one lane through the work zone beginning April 28 for pavement repair in preparation for resurfacing. Work is being performed by Shelly Co., Findlay.

Ohio 330 from Ohio 15 to Vanlue High School will be restricted to one lane through the work zone late in the week of April 28 for pavement repair in preparation for resurfacing. Work is being performed by Shelly Co., Findlay.

Hardin County

Ohio 309 from the Kenton corporation limit to the Marion County line will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for pavement sealing. Work is being performed by the Hardin County ODOT maintenance garage.

Ohio 701 between County Road 65 and County Road 75 will close April 28 for four days for a culvert and catch basin replacement project. Traffic detoured onto Ohio 309 and U.S. 68 back to Ohio 701. Work is being performed by the Hardin County ODOT maintenance garage.

Ohio 31 from the Kenton corporation limit to Mt Victory will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for pavement sealing. Work is being performed by the Hardin County ODOT maintenance garage.

Paulding County

There are no projects scheduled during the week which will have a significant impact on traffic.

Putnam County

U.S. 224 from just east of the village of Ottawa to just east of Gilboa will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for sealing of pavement cracks. Work is being performed by the Putnam

County ODOT maintenance garage.

Ohio 108 in the village of Miller City will be closed beginning April 21 for two weeks for railroad crossing repair. Traffic detoured onto Ohio 613, Ohio 109 and Ohio 18 back to Ohio 108. Work is being performed by Roadsafe.

Van Wert County

U.S. 127 north of Van Wert will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for sealing of pavement cracks. Work is being performed by the Van Wert County ODOT maintenance garage.

Wyandot County

There are no projects scheduled during the week which will have a significant impact on traffic.
